

Synopsis

ACT TWO - MUNCHKINLAND & THE YELLOW BRICK ROAD

Dorothy lands in a magical land and is hailed a hero for accidentally defeating the Wicked Witch of the East. Glinda, the Good Witch, gives Dorothy a pair of enchanted ruby slippers and advises her to follow the Yellow Brick Road to find the Wizard of Oz. Along the way, Dorothy befriends a Scarecrow who longs for a brain, a Tin Man in search of a heart, and a Cowardly Lion desperate for courage. Together, they face strange creatures, mocking crows, enchanted forests, and the looming threat of the Wicked Witch of the West.

ACT THREE - THE EMERALD CITY

The group reaches the Emerald City and is welcomed by its quirky citizens. To earn the Wizard's help, they are tasked with retrieving the Wicked Witch's broomstick. Determined, they set off toward the Witch's dark castle, unaware of the traps that await them.

ACT SIX - BACK IN KANSAS



The wonderful Wizard of Oz!




If Only I Had A Brain
